#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students may pursue courses of study and complete requirements for an Associate in Arts degree, Associate in Applied Science degree, or a Career Certificate.

1. To graduate from the College with an Associate in Arts degree, completion of the basic core of **General Education** courses is required. Students must earn 64 semester hours including

**a. Orientation or Honors Forum** 2 semester hours

**E nglish Composition** 6 semester hours

**H umanities** 6 semester hours

(History, Literature, Philosophy, Religion)

**Fine Arts** 3 semester hours

(Art/Music Appreciation, Art History)

**Social Science** 9 semester hours

(Economics, Geography, History,

Political Science, Psychology, Sociology)

**College Algebra or higher lever math** 3 semester hours

**L aboratory Science** 8 semester hours

(Biology, Botany, Chemistry, Microbiology,

Anatomy & Physiology, Physical Science,

Physics, Zoology)

**O ral Communication** (Public Speaking) 3 semester hours

Electives subject to approval to complete the total hours required. Note that

**developmental courses will not count towards graduation requirements.**
