The following changes have been made to the graduation requirements from the College with an Associate in Applied Science degree (page 65 of the 2008-2010 College Catalog):

---

p. 65

2. To graduate from the College with an Associate in Applied Science degree, students must:
- a. Complete requirements from an outlined curriculum stated in a specified catalog not more than three years old which includes a minimum of 17 semester credit hours of program specified general education core courses. The general education core will contain core courses from the following:

Orientation	2 semester hours
English Composition	6 semester hours
<del>Humanities</del>	<del>6 semester hours</del>
<del>(History, Literature, Philosophy, Religion)</del>	
<del>Fine Arts</del>	<del>3 semester hours</del>
<del>(Art/Music Appreciation, Art History)</del>	
Social Science	3 semester hours
<del>(Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology)</del>	
College Algebra or higher level math	3 semester hours
<del>Laboratory Science</del>	<del>8 semester hours</del>
<del>(Biology, botany, Chemistry, Microbiology, Anatomy &amp; Physiology, Physical Science, Physics, Zoology)</del>	
Oral Communication (Public speaking)	3 semester hours
  - b. Note that developmental courses will not count towards graduation requirements.
  - c. Successfully complete LLS 1312 Orientation.
  - d. Earn a minimum 2.0 GPA.
  - e. Complete one semester residence at Jones County Junior College.
  - f. Earn not more than 25 percent of the work for graduation by extension and/or correspondence.\*
