

Addendum to the JCJC Pre-criminal Justice Curriculum

Starting fall 2007 the following changes have been made to the pre-criminal justice curriculum (page 131 of the 2006-2008 Catalog):

CRJ 2313 Police Operations has been replaced by *CRJ 1323 Police Administration and Operations*
CRJ 2213 Traffic Law has been replaced by *CRJ 1363 Introduction to Corrections*
CRJ 2393 Survey of Criminalistics has been replaced by *CRJ 2513 Law Enforcement and the Juvenile*

Course Descriptions

CRJ 1323 Police Administration and Operations - Principles of organization and administration in law enforcement as applied to the law enforcement agencies; introduction to concepts of organizational behavior.

CRJ 1363 Introduction to Corrections - An overview of the correctional field; its origins, historical and philosophical background, development, current status, relationship with other facets of the criminal justice system and future prospects.

CRJ 2513 Law enforcement and the Juvenile - The role of police in juvenile delinquency and control. Organization, functions, and jurisdiction of juvenile agencies. Processing, detention, and disposition of cases. Statutes and court procedures applied to juveniles.
