

## ALGEBRA PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR ADVISORS

A student should register for College Algebra only if

- (1) a grade of A or B was made in Intermediate Algebra
- or
- (2) a score of 18 or higher was made on the math portion of the ACT if Intermediate Algebra was not taken.

If neither of these prerequisites is met, the student must take the Accuplacer test in the Computer Lab. No appointment is needed; the test has no time limit, but students usually finish in 20 to 45 minutes. The student should bring you the score sheet.

If the Accuplacer score is below 76, please convince the student to take Intermediate Algebra.

If the Accuplacer score is below 40, the student should take Beginning Algebra.
