JCJC CURRICULUM SHEET

The program illustrated is designed to prepare students to enter the field of Forestry at Mississippi State University. The Forestry major includes three academic options: Forest Management Option, Wildlife Management Option, and Environmental Conservation Option. Additionally, The Department of Forest Products offers two additional options: Wood Industries Management and Wood Materials Science.

The sample curriculum satisfies core courses of the Forest Products major at MSU. Graduates are prepared to work in diversified careers involving the understanding of an management of forested ecosystems. In related options in the Forestry Major, the student is prepared for the marketing, technical service, and research of forest products. (A two-year terminal program in Forestry is also available, leading to the Associate in Applied Science degree on the JCJC campus. Consult the JCJC catalog or the Forestry advisor for information on the two-year program.)

The student should consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.
