NOTES:

Recitals, a major performing group (band or choir), and major applied study are required of music majors every semester in attendance at JCJC.

Students pursuing a major or minor in music should maintain close contact with their JCJC advisor for selection of appropriate courses and to obtain other information.

Students should plan to complete no more than half of the hours required for the bachelor's degree prior to transferring to the senior institution. The student should consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

Voice and Instrumental Emphasis should take piano as the minor applied music. Piano majors can take either voice or an instrument as the minor applied, but voice is recommended.
