**OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY -- NOTES:**

The student should be aware that the prerequisite for A&P is one semester of a biological science or chemistry.

Trigonometry is a prerequisite for Physics.

Students without an adequate high school math background, which includes a minimum of Algebra II, should enroll in a preparatory math course, such as Basic Math, Beginning Algebra or Intermediate Algebra, prior to College Algebra. Preparatory math courses will not transfer to other institutions.

History may be used for either a Social Science or Humanity. Both American and Western Civilization may be selected, if needed, to meet credit hours required for JCJC graduation or OT admission.

A minimum grade point average of C is required on each course accepted for transfer. The overall minimum grade point average is 2.0, although a 2.0 GPA is usually far below the class average of successful applicants.

A minimum total of sixteen hours of observation is required in two Occupational Therapy clinical departments as part of the application requirements.

One class is admitted each summer. Application must be submitted by the preceding January 15.

Applicants to the professional program at (UMMC) are urged to begin the application process early in the sophomore year. Selection of students into the professional program is made by an admissions committee. An interview is required. Application packets contain all the necessary forms and instructions for the application process.

The student should consult the UMMC catalog for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

This CHECK SHEET should be used to keep a careful record of grades for each of the courses and should be presented to the student's advisor for planning the schedule of courses for each semester at JCJC.
