5. Bass Clarinet: Change #3-fast; Keep #4
6. Contrabass Clarinet and Bari Sax: Add a fast one
7. Alto and Tenor Sax: Change #1-fast; Keep #4

Addendum: Proposal was made to work on Brass music the same way.

Percussion music is needed-Dr. Hill appointed (read *railroaded*) to look into this.
