

JONES ONSTAGE BIO

Jones OnStage is Jones County Junior College's high-energy show group. Performing some thirty shows per year, this highly-acclaimed ensemble is featured at campus and community events, civic functions, festivals, youth events, pageants, high schools, corporate shows, and show choir competitions. They present an exciting, visual program of high-energy, audience-grabbing song-and-dance routines. Their dynamic vocals draw from a repertoire ranging across the spectrum of musical styles including pop, Motown, classic rock, Broadway, country, hip hop, gospel, and disco.

During their thirteen year history, Jones OnStage has appeared with celebrities Suzanne Somers of Three's Company; Vicki Lawrence of Mama's Family; comedian and red carpet hostess Joan Rivers; Designing Women's Delta Burke, and Rue McLanahan who played Blanche on The Golden Girls. They have also shared the stage with Robert Urich of TV classics Vega\$ and Spenser: For Hire; Luci Arnaz, daughter of Lucille Ball; actor and talk show host Tony Danza; country music's Crystal Gayle, the Fonz from Happy Days, Henry Winkler; and Della Reese, singer and star of Touched by an Angel. In April, they will appear with television and movie actress Patty Duke.

Jones OnStage is honored to have been invited to host FAME Chicago national high school show choir competition this year. Preparation and travel to Chicago, attending the Broadway show Wicked and experiencing Blue Man Group from the first two rows of the theater where performer Charlana Lowery was part of the show, along with sightseeing in Chicago, were highlights of the year. Performing in exhibition for the competing FAME show choirs was indeed an honor that won't be forgotten. The trip was a wonderful experience and very rewarding following a year of hard work.

Jones OnStage's show is designed by choreographer Michael Weaver and director Joe Mauldin, and their custom soundtracks are produced in Nashville by JCJC alumnus Reggie Smith, gospel artist and featured performer on the Gaither Homecoming television and video series. Most vocals are arranged by the students and Mr. Mauldin. Jones OnStage performances typically last approximately forty-five minutes to an hour.

Comprised of talented singers, dancers, and technicians from many different majors throughout the college, group members receive full tuition scholarships.
