HUMANITIES -- NOTES:

The curriculum for majors in the humanities may be used as a pre-Bachelor of Arts or pre-Bachelor of Science degree program. Students interested in the B.S. program should consult the catalog of the senior institution and make appropriate modifications.

Students without an adequate high school math background, which includes a minimum of Algebra II, should enroll in a preparatory math course, such as Basic Math, Beginning Algebra or Intermediate Algebra, prior to College Algebra. Preparatory math courses will not transfer to other institutions.

Additionally, students should plan to complete no more than half of the hours required for a bachelor's degree prior to transferring to the senior institution. The student should consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

Science - Students majoring in the Humanities (listed at top of first page) planning to attend USM with the intention of seeking teacher certification should take 8 hours of lab science. One course should be in biological science, and the other course should be in the area of natural science. Example: BIO 1134 (General Biology I) and PHY 2244 (Physical Science I) would meet the science requirements for Humanities majors at USM. Students planning to attend UM & MSU need to take 12 hours of lab science.

This CHECK SHEET should be used to keep a careful record of grades for each of the courses and should be presented to the student's advisor for planning the schedule of courses each semester at JCJC.
