JCJC CURRICULUM SHEET

The sample curriculum below is the first phase of a 2 + 2 program. In the first phase, students must complete a minimum of 63 semester hours prior to enrolling in a School of Nursing as a junior. In the second phase, called the professional phase, the students complete the curriculum in a School of Nursing and receive the Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing (B.S.N.). Selection of students into the professional program is made by an admissions committee.

At USM & UMMC an Enhanced ACT composite score of 21 or above is required. Students should contact the School of Nursing at either USM, William Carey, or The University of Mississippi Medical Center one semester before the time they are ready to transfer. Students should be aware that deadlines and course requirements may change. The student should also consult the senior institution's current catalog for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study. Classes are generally enrolled in August and January for USM and fall only for UMMC. Courses followed by an asterisk (*) are CORE REQUIREMENTS for the Bachelors Degree program.

NURSING - BACHELOR'S DEGREE -- NOTES:

All pre-nursing students should have a nursing faculty advisor assigned by Student Services. The student should consult with their JCJC advisor for assistance in preparing for application for admission and is strongly advised to consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

The student should note that the prerequisite for A&P I in the college catalog. Before enrolling in A & P I, a student must have a minimum ACT score of 21 on the Science component, or one of the following courses BIO 1134, BIO 1144, BIO 2414, or admission to a health related program at JCJC, or instructor's permission.

Students without an adequate high school math background, which includes a minimum of Algebra II, should enroll in a preparatory math course, such as Basic Math, Beginning Algebra, or Intermediate Algebra, prior to College Algebra. Preparatory math courses will not transfer to other institutions.

Students without a high school background in chemistry should enroll in CHE 1114, Basic Chemistry. While this course will not transfer in pre-nursing, it does provide the student with the opportunity for successful work in the required general chemistry courses. CHE 1114 also meets the prerequisite requirement for A&P.

Generally, applicants must present a minimum overall grade point average of 2.50 or better on all work attempted. Additionally, applicants must complete all nonprofessional nursing courses and achieve a grade of C or better prior to transferring.

Chemistry. USM does not require Chemistry for a BSN degree. William Carey requires 4 hours of Chemistry and UMMC requires 8 hours of Chemistry for a BSN degree.

Business. Statistics is required at USM. BAD 2323 (Business Statistics) will transfer and meet the requirement for statistics in the USM BSN program. USM also requires ECO 2123 (Economics II) for a BSN degree. Economics 2123 is an elective at UMMC. (Economics I does not have to be taken before Economics II.) CSC 1113 (Computer Concepts) is required at UMMC for the BSN degree.

In addition to philosophy and literature, applicants to William Carey's nursing program must take two courses in Religion and Physical Education.

UMMC requires 18 semester hours in psychological and social sciences, which could be fulfilled with the following: 3 semester hours in History; 3 semester hours each in General Psychology, Sociology, Human Growth and Development, and Family (Marriage and Family) or a course in Economics or Political Science.

A course in *Logic* is required at USM. **PHI 2113, Introduction to Philosophy meets the Logic requirement at USM.**

This CHECK SHEET should be used to keep a careful record of grades for each of the courses and should be presented to the student's advisor for planning the schedule of courses each semester at JCJC.
