PHYSICAL EDUCATION -- NOTES:

A&P. One semester of biology, zoology, or chemistry is a prerequisite for BIO 2514 Anatomy & Physiology. It should be noted that USM specifies only one semester of A&P. The sports medicine program, however, requires two semesters of A&P.

If the student selects Sports Administration specialization, then several business courses must be included:

ACC 1213 Accounting I
ECO 2113 Economics I
BAD 2533 Business and Microcomputers

Students without an adequate high school math background, which includes a minimum of Algebra II, should enroll in a preparatory math course, such as Basic Math, Beginning Algebra or Intermediate Algebra, prior to College Algebra. Preparatory math courses will not transfer to other institutions.

Additionally, students should plan to complete no more than half of the hours required for a bachelor's degree prior to transferring to the senior institution. The student should consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

This CHECK SHEET should be used to keep a careful record of grades for each of the courses and should be presented to the student's advisor for planning the schedule of courses each semester at JCJC.
