SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES -- NOTES:

+ As an alternative, the student may select 8 hrs. of Physical Science or Chemistry and 4 hrs. Of Biology. A total of 12 hrs. of science is needed. If no high school chemistry was taken, CHE 1114 should be taken.

Electives in the major area and related courses should be selected to bring the total to 64 semester hours.

Four semesters of a single foreign language are usually required for those taking degrees under Liberal Arts in most senior institutions. JCJC offers French and Spanish. The student is encouraged to consult the catalog of the senior institution and plan the language and other courses to coincide with prospective senior institution's CORE REQUIREMENTS. Usually the student will begin with French (MFL 1113 and MFL 1123) or Spanish (MFL 1213 and MFL 1223) and proceed through the intermediate level in the language to satisfy the requirement. The student should complete all foreign language requirements on one campus.

William Carey also requires two semesters of religion and physical education activity.

Students without an adequate high school math background, which includes a minimum of Algebra II, should enroll in a preparatory math course, such as Basic Math, Beginning Algebra or Intermediate Algebra, prior to College Algebra. Preparatory math courses will not transfer to other institutions.

Additionally, students should plan to complete no more than half of the hours required for a bachelor's degree prior to transferring to the senior institution. The student should consult the catalog of the senior institution for specific admissions procedures and other details concerning the program of study.

This CHECK SHEET should be used to keep a careful record of grades for each of the courses and should be presented to the student's advisor for planning the schedule of courses each semester at JCJC.
