Jones College Sponsored Travel

Jones College continues to monitor the spread of the COVID-19 Novel Corona Virus 2019. Based on a report from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the United States and many other countries are affected. The CDC issued yesterday, March 9, 2020, its recommendations to Institutions of Higher Education (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/student-foreign-travel.html>) with students who are participating in international travel or study abroad programs.

The CDC explicitly recommended that Institutions of Higher Education consider postponing or canceling international travel programs. Based on that recommendation, Jones College is officially suspending college-sponsored international travel. Also, the college is suspending college-sponsored travel to U.S. cities that have declared a State-of-Emergency in response to COVID-19.
