College Operations

Your instructor will provide more details about how that will work for your particular class. The in-person instruction will occur during the listed time period of the class, but students will report to campus in small groups with your instructor. Your instructor will communicate the specific schedule to you.

- High risk individuals will need to notify their instructor to make arrangements to complete coursework fully online or should consider fully online class options for the summer.
