CAMPUS UPDATE

The *Campus Update* section of this communication will provide information from departments across the campus community regarding changing operations regarding COVID-19.

College Operations

Jones College operate under normal employee operations beginning Tuesday, May 26, 2020 until further notice. Buildings are open to the public. Everyone is required to wear masks and social distance when conducting on-campus business.

Mobile Campus Clinic

The Jones College Campus Clinic will offer mobile services to our campus community (students and employees) beginning Monday, March 23, 2020, until further notice. The Mobile Clinic will operate Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. To schedule an appointment with Mobile Clinic, send an email to CampusClinic@jcc.edu.

June 2020 Summer Classes

Face masks must be worn at all times while on campus and everyone entering a classroom will be required to have a colored sticker that indicates you have been screened for the day. Faculty will only admit those who have been screened. Those who have a temperature will be asked to return home or make an appointment with the Campus Clinic before being allowed to attend class. Students are asked to self-report any direct contact with a COVID-19 case. Students will be assisted in a “Learn from Home” environment if quarantined. Please continue to safely practice all CDC guidelines in order to keep your family and the Jones family safe.

The June 2020 Guidelines to return to Campus are as follows:

- Students will need to be screened prior to entering class. Faculty members will check for a screening sticker while verifying attendance.
- Students are responsible for obtaining their screening sticker from designated locations on campus prior to entering classroom buildings.
- Screening stickers will change colors each day.
- Students will be screened for temperature using an infrared thermometer.
- Students must wear a MASK while attending class. Student masks may be handmade but must prevent the spread of droplets from nose and mouth.
- Students are expected to maintain 6 feet of space between themselves and other students.
- Students are expected to self-report if they have had direct contact with someone with COVID-19; students will coordinate with faculty member to “Learn From Home” during quarantine time
- Students will not congregate in common areas.
- Students in night classes will be screened by a faculty member.

- Students may make an appointment with the Campus Clinic by calling 477-4104 if you feel ill or have symptoms of COVID-19.
