Policy Statement - No solicitation shall be conducted on any property, street, or sidewalk, or in any building, structure, or facility owned or controlled by Jones College without prior approval from the Executive Vice President of Student Affairs.

Definition - Solicitation shall be defined as any advertisement of or promotional effort through any sale of tickets, products, services and giveaways by a non-profit or for-profit organization..

- A. Distribution of written materials for solicitation by non-employees on College property is prohibited.
- B. Solicitation by employees is prohibited in working areas or during working time.
- C. College bulletin boards are for the College's use only. The use of College premises and facilities for any purpose other than school-related business is subject to advance arrangements and specific approval by the Executive Vice President of Student Affairs.
- D. Nothing in this policy prohibits the sales or solicitation to the College in its normal course of business.
